SPECIAL ALL AGE STAKE: There will be a SPECIAL all-age stake and not an OPEN at this trial. "A Special All-Age Stake at a Retriever trial shall be for dogs that, during the period comprised of the previous calendar year and the current calendar year prior to the date of closing of entries for such trial, have been placed or awarded a Judges' Award of Merit in an Open All-Age, Limited All-Age, Special All-age, Amateur All-Age, or Owner-Handler Amateur All-Age Stake carrying Championship points in each case, or have been placed first or second in a Qualifying Stake."

RUNNING ORDER: The starting number of the All-Age Stakes will be determined by close of the Dow Jones Industrial Average on Tuesday, May 16, 2006.

SCRATCH POLICY: All scratch notifications must be made to the Field Trial Secretary prior to the start of the stake. Full refund for scratches will be made to bitches in season and for illness or injury with a vet's certificate received within 10 days following the trial. There will be a \$25 scratch fee for all other scratches. No refund will be made for "no shows."

GROUNDS: The Mid-Illinois Retriever Club, Inc. rents the trial grounds from Mr. Dick Anderson. Please help us remain welcome on these grounds by following a DO NOT LITTER POLICY and by CLOSING AND CHAINING THE GATE AT ALL TIMES. ABSOLUTELY NO FISHING IS ALLOWED AT ANY TIME. Twenty minutes after the last dog has run, the gates will be closed. Be sure you are out of the ground as soon as possible or you will be locked in!

Lunch will be provided from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Friday and Saturday. Lunch may also be available on Sunday, dependent upon interest.
